## Combustion Motor Gasket

**WARNING: BE SURE TO READ YOUR OWNER'S MANUAL BEFORE INSTALLING OR OPERATING YOUR STOVE.  
ALWAYS FOLLOW ALL CODES.**

If you remove the motor from the Combustion Blower housing (i.e. for cleaning), the Combustion Motor Gasket (Part # **PU-CMG**) should be replaced. You can remove the motor from the blower housing without removing the entire Combustion Blower from the stove.

After removing the access panel from the stove, disconnect the power leads at the Combustion Blower.

Using a 11/32 socket, remove the six nuts that connect the motor mount flange to the Combustion Blower housing (see Ill. 1).

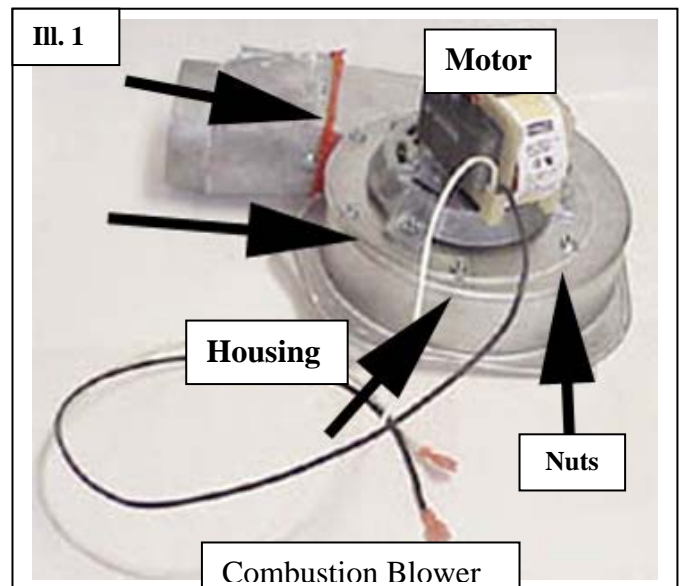
Remove the motor and the impeller from the housing.

With a putty knife, scrape off any excess gasket material from the motor mounting flange and the blower housing.

If cleaning your blower, the blower impeller, blower tube and steel blower exhaust tube on the unit should be brushed and vacuumed.

Install a replacement PU-CMG Combustion Motor Gasket and reverse the above procedure to install the motor back onto the blower housing.
